### Children's Workshops

Dear parents/carers,

Thank you for booking on to our children's workshops at Woburn Safari Park. Please read the following information carefully and do not hesitate to contact us if you have any questions.

#### **Arrangements for dropping off children**

**The day begins promptly at 8:30am**, the education team will be available to **receive children from 8:20am onwards**.

Please ensure that children are dropped off at the **SENse the Safari Education Centre (no.31 on the map)**. Please ensure that the consent form with emergency contact and medical information has been returned. You may bring this with you on the day or email in advance, your child will not be admitted without this form.

Enter the Park via the **entrance in Husborne Crawley**, the postcode for this entrance is **MK43 OXB (what3words-windmills.image.establish)**, please go over the cattle grid and continue straight ahead. You will get to a second cattle grid, go over this and turn left. You will see our farmyard on the right hand side, please drive up the hill and go through the yellow gate to the car park.

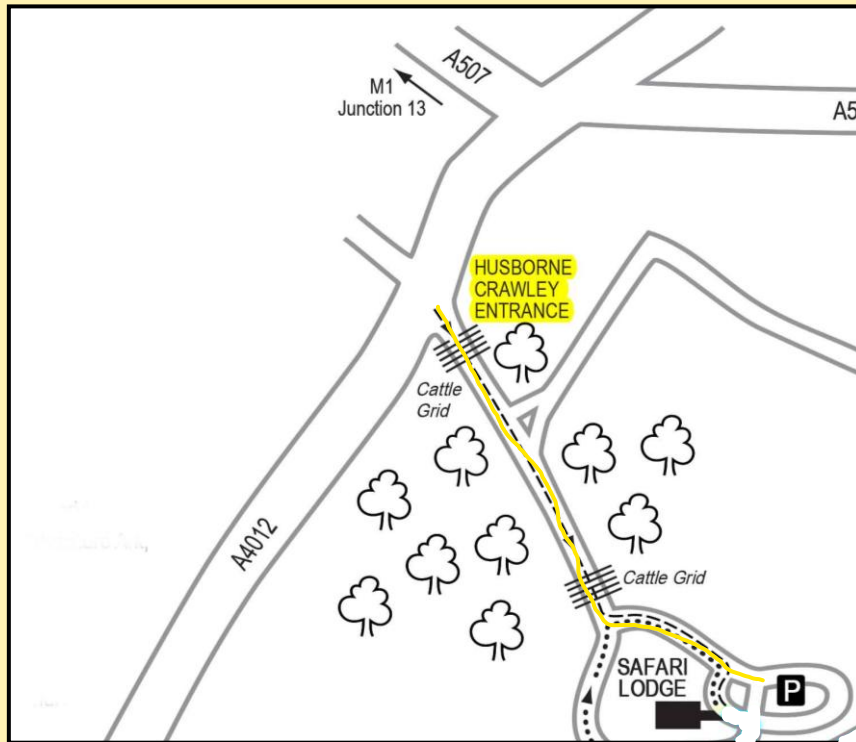
As the Park is closed at this time, this is the only way to access the classroom.

### Arrangements for collecting children

Please pick your child/children up at 3:30pm from the **SENSe the Safari Classroom (no.31 on the map)**. To enter the Park, follow signs for the main entrance and drive to the ticket lanes. Use the pass below to gain entrance from **3:10pm onwards**. You must present this pass to gain free entry.

- **No pets or dogs are allowed in the park, so please do not bring them with you!**

Parking is available in the main car park. You will need to sign your child out before leaving the building.

### Parents Pass

This entitles the holder to enter the Park free of charge for the purpose of collecting participants. It is not a free admission ticket for the Park's facilities. This is valid for one adult unless prior agreement is made.

### Daily equipment

- Suitable clothing for working outside with the animals – they will get mucky! e.g. waterproof coats, wellington boots, sunhat
- Suitable footwear; many activities are outdoor and involve walking
- Cameras are welcome and encouraged, although no responsibility can be taken for any damage or loss.
- Any medication that they require
- Lunch & snacks (unless pre-ordered)

### Behaviour of children

We aim to give children the best experience possible. For safety reasons and for the welfare of other children attending, we must ask children to show good behaviour at all times. In the morning, we will develop a set of rules as a group which the children are expected to adhere to throughout the day. Children not showing appropriate behaviour during activities will not be allowed to continue with the activity for their safety and that of the animals. If this behaviour persists, children will not be allowed to complete the day. We will operate a card system; a yellow card acts as a warning and a red card signifies that the child will not be allowed to continue the activity.

Behaviour constituting a red card includes:

- Harming or attempting to harm animals
- Exhibiting rude, abusive or threatening behaviour to another child, staff member or park visitor
- Repeatedly ignoring staff that are giving instructions
- Acting in any way that could compromise their safety or the safety of other children, animals, staff members or park visitors.

We will inform parents of any unacceptable behaviour. I am sure you will understand that we must take every action to ensure that we create a safe, friendly environment for all children attending this event.
