BIRDS

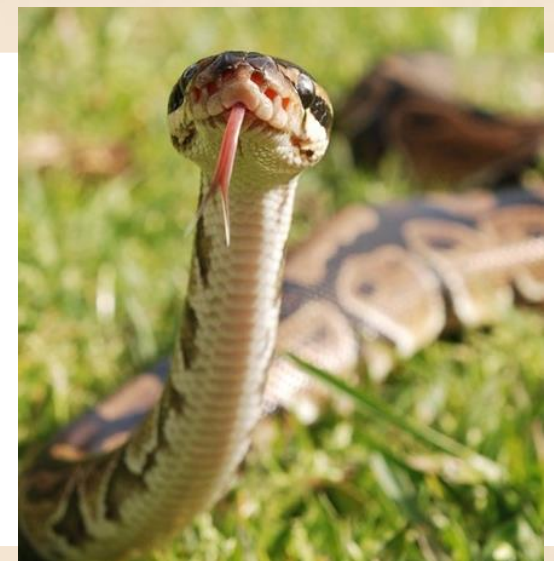
REPTILES

Scales: Animals covered in dry scales are called reptiles. Reptiles don't have anything on their body to keep them warm, so they will often sit in the sun to warm up.

How many legs?: Four or None at all

Little ones: Most reptiles lay eggs

INSECTS

Hard bodies: Unlike mammals, birds and reptiles, insects have their skeleton on the outside of their bodies to give them more protection

How many legs?: Six

Little ones: insects lay many tiny eggs

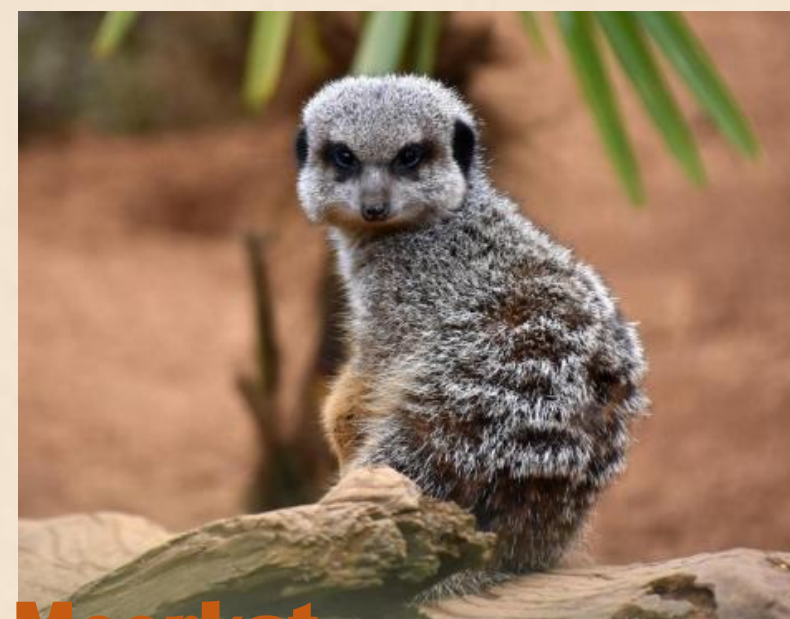
