From 27th March to 15th October: Open daily from 9.30am to 5.45pm, with last entry to the Park and Road Safari at 4.45pm.



NO.	ACTIVITY/LOCATION	OPENING TIME	INFORMATION
13	Mammoth Play Ark	Open from 10.30am to 5.15pm	Height restrictions apply on selected slides. Long sleeves, trouser and socks must be worn on larger slides. Times may be limited to 20 minute play sessions during peak times. Adult supervision required <u>at all times</u> .
10	Great Woburn Railway	Runs every half hour from 12pm	Train departs from Bison Halt . Train times are every half-hour: 12pm, 12.30pm, 1pm, 1.30pm, 2pm, 2.30pm, 3pm, 3.30pm, 4pm, 4.30pm and 5pm. Does not stop at Alpaca Outpost .
21	Swan Boats and Dragon Boats on Swan Lake	10:30am to 5:15pm* (last boat leaves half an hour before the Park closes)	Pedal powered boats. Children under 16 must be accompanied by an adult. Suitable for ages 3 and over. Min height restriction 1m applies.
4	Bobcat Run	12.00pm to 5pm	Giant astra slide suitable for all the family. Min. height restriction of 1.3m. Open subject to weather conditions.
16	Outdoor Play Area	Open during Park opening hours	Unsupervised play area – adult supervision required <u>at all times</u> .
24	Tiny Tots Safari Trail	Open during Park opening hours	Soft bouncy castle play areas for under 5's. Adult supervision required. Adult supervision required <u>at all times</u> .
32	Giraffe Trail High Ropes	12.00pm-5pm	Subject to availability, additional charge applies. Suitable for children aged 5 to 12 years old and over 1.1 m tall. Sturdy footwear required. Tickets are available from the high ropes cabin during weekends and school holidays and from Junglies Gift Shop 28 weekday term time.
18	Sea Lion Cove	Please see talks and demonstration timetable for times	Indoor sea lion demonstration and cinema. An additional £2 charge applies per person. Pay at Junglies Gift Shop 28 on weekdays, or at the Trading Post 15 on weekends and school holidays.
12	Go Ape	Walk up to the cabin to ask for availability today	From 1st April to 30th October: Open daily during Bedfordshire school holidays. Closed on Tuesdays during school term times.
28	Junglies Gift Shop	Open during Park opening hours	Open for gifts and souvenirs. Ask a member of staff about late availability for VIP Experiences on the day of your visit.
29	Safari Restaurant	9.30am to 5.30pm	Hot food is served daily until 4.45pm. Open for light refreshments until 5.30pm. Indoor seating is reserved for Safari Restaurant customers only.
13	2x2 Restaurant (in the Mammoth Play Ark)	11am to 4.30pm	Serving hot food, drinks and snacks between 11am-4.30pm on weekends and school holidays only.
7	Piglet's Pantry at the Lookout Café	12pm to 4.30pm	Open at weekends and school holidays only. Delicious cakes, snacks and drinks.

USEFUL INFORMATION

- The Safari Park is 360 acres and the Road Safari will take around an hour to complete.
- You can do as many repeat circuits of the Road Safari as you like, before closing time.
- Road Safari (entry via main gate or re-entry route) closes one hour before park closing time.
- Foot Safari animal walk-throughs close 30 minutes before park closing time, except for Farmyard Friends which closes one hour before.

ANY PROBLEMS?

FIRST AID: Qualified First Aiders and a well equipped First Aid Room are available on site. Please notify a member of staff if you need First Aid and assistance will be organised.

LOST CHILD: If a child is lost, then please contact a member of staff immediately. We have a well practiced lost child procedure.

LOST PROPERTY: If you have lost something or wish to hand in lost property, please report to Junglies Gift Shop.

PROBLEM OR COMPLAINT: Please ask a member of staff to contact the Duty Manager during your visit so we can resolve any problem for you immediately.

SAFETY IN THE PARK

- Car doors and windows must be kept closed at all times in the Road Safari.
- Stay in your car and sound your horn if you have a problem.
- DO NOT FEED** the animals. They are fed on special diets and you could make them seriously ill. If you are caught feeding the animals you will be asked to leave the park and no refund will be payable.
- No dogs or BBQ's are permitted anywhere on site.
- Children under the age of 16 years must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- Please keep moving slowly through the Road Safari and do not block any gates.
- Please wash your hands after any supervised contact with the animals. Hand washing points are situated throughout the Foot Safari.
- Woburn Safari Park reserves the right to ask any visitor to leave the site, should they behave in an inappropriate or unsafe manner.
